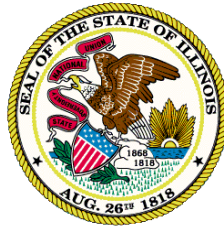

P R O C L A M A T I O N


WHEREAS, the Division of Banking finds that on December 29, 2017, a significant weather emergency occurred affecting several branch offices of Heartland Bank and Trust in Illinois, suspending normal operations of the following locations (collectively, the "Branches"):

108 North Main Street, Eureka, Illinois 61530
1821 South Main Street, Eureka, Illinois 61530

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 2 of the Banking Emergencies Act [205 ILCS 610/2], the Division of Banking authorizes each Branch of Heartland to close for all or part of the normal business days of December 29, 2017, and thereafter, until such time as normal business operations are no longer affected by the emergency.
