Any interested person may testify at the hearings, provided that he or she gives written notice to the Director of the Division of Financial Institutions of his or her intention to do so at least five (5) days prior to the commencement of the hearings. In the event that the deadline for the filing of such notice falls on a day when the Division of Financial Institutions is not open for business, then the deadline shall be extended to the next available date on which the Division is open for business. Any person failing to file timely notice of his or her intention to testify will not be permitted to testify at the public hearings. In addition, any interested person may make a written submission of his or her views, comments, data or arguments by filing said written submission with the Director of the Division of Financial Institutions no later than 5:00 PM on the last day of the scheduled public hearings, except as to all written submissions which set forth information in the nature of expert testimony.
