

Based upon the above findings the Secretary hereby concludes the following:

1. By virtue of the failure to timely submit a complete license application, Action Pawn violated Section 38 Ill. Adm. Code, Section 360.160; and
2. Pursuant to the authority provided under Section 0.05(a)(2) of the Act, the Secretary has determined that it is appropriate to enter an Order Assessing a Late Filing Fee against Action Pawn.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Action Pawn shall be and hereby is assessed a late filing fee in the amount of \$300;
2. The late filing fee in the amount of \$300 shall be paid no later than ninety (90) days after service of this Order upon Action Pawn; and
3. The late filing fee in the amount of \$300 shall be paid by means of a certified check or money order made payable to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (IDFPR).
