

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Secretary CONCLUDES:

1. That by virtue of its failure to timely file its Disclosure Report for calendar year 2007, IRJS Jewelers, Inc. violated 38 Ill. Adm. Code, Section 360.210(a).

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. IRJS Jewelers, Inc. shall be and hereby is assessed a civil monetary penalty in the amount of \$450 (\$50 per day for 8 days) pursuant to Section 0.05(a)(6) of the Act;
2. The civil monetary penalty in the amount of \$450 shall be paid no later than sixty (60) days after service of this order upon IRJS Jewelers, Inc.; and
3. The civil monetary penalty in the amount of \$450 shall be paid by means of a certified check or money order made payable to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (IDFPR).
