ORDER REMOVING SUSPENSION

The DEPARTMENT OF FINANICAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION, Division of Banks and Real Estate, (the "Department), having conducted an examination of the facts related to American Mortgage Group, Inc., 7707 W. Adm. Code 1050], hereby issues this ORDER pursuant to the authority provided under Section 4-5 of the Act. The Department makes the following:

FINDINGS

- 1. That American Mortgage Group, Inc., is an Illinois residential mortgage Licensee holding license No. MB.0004519 and located at 7707 W. Main Street, Suite 4, Belleville, Illinois, 62223;
- 2. That the Department issued to Licensee Order No. 2004-MBR-63b on August 27, 2004; and
- 3. That Licensee provided change of address and copy of current surety bond to the Department.

CONCLUSIONS

BASED UPON THE ABOVE FINDINGS, THE DEPARTMENT IS OF THE OPINION AND CONCLUDES:

- 1. That on September 24, 2004 BRE received payment of the assessed penalty fee in the amount of \$2,100.00;
- 2. That Licensee is currently complying with the Act and Rules promulgated under the Act.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the suspension of AMERICAN

MORTGAGE GROUP, INC., license No. MB.0004519, is hereby removed.
