ORDER ASSESSING FINE

The DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION, Division of Banking (the "Department"), having conducted a review of activities conducted by **Equibanc**, (the "Licensee") and having documented violations of the Residential Mortgage License Act of 1987 (the "Act") [205 ILCS 635] and the rules promulgated under the Act (the "Rules") [38 III. Adm. Code 1050], hereby issues this ORDER pursuant to the authority provided under Section 4-5 of the Act. The Department makes the following:

FINDINGS

- 1. That Equibanc is an Illinois residential mortgage licensee holding license number MB.0006499 (the "License"), and located at 5333 Mission Center Rd, Suite 380, San Diego, California 92108;
- 2. That Licensee has failed to perform one or more of the requirements of the Act and Rules described below:
 - a. Failure of Licensee to maintain Surety Bond and Fidelity Bond (205 ILCS 635/3-1 and 38 Ill. Admin. Code 1050.490);
- 3. That the Department made efforts as described below to advise Licensee of these unfulfilled requirements so that Licensee can comply with the Act and Rules:
 - a. That on April 30, 2007, the Department received a Notice of Cancellation letter from Licensee's Insurance Company indicating that surety bond coverage shall expire on June 5, 2007:
 - b. That on May 1, 2007, the Department sent to Licensee via U.S. first-class mail service and certified mail, a letter advising Licensee that the surety bond on file with the Department has been cancelled, that licensee's fidelity bond expired on

February 20, 2007, and that such current bonds must be submitted to Department within 10 days;

- c. That a Potential Disciplinary Letter was sent to Licensee on August 9, 2007 via U.S. first-class mail service and certified mail; and
- d. That Licensee has not submitted to the Department a current surety bond and a current fidelity bond by the due date.

CONCLUSIONS

BASED UPON THE ABOVE FINDINGS, THE DEPARTMENT IS OF THE OPINION AND CONCLUDES:

- 1. That notwithstanding notices and other efforts by the Department, Licensee failed to respond and submit a current surety bond and fidelity bond to the Department in a timely manner; and
- 2. That Licensee is not currently complying with the Act and Rules promulgated under the Act.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. That Equibanc, License No. MB.0006499 shall be and hereby is assessed a fine in the amount of \$5,000;
- 2. The fine in the amount of \$5,000 shall be paid no later than thirty (30) days after service of this Order upon Equibanc; and
- 3. The fine in the amount of \$5,000 shall be paid by means of a certified check or money order made payable to the:
