## **ORDER ASSESSING FINE**

The DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION, Division of Banking (the "Department"), having conducted a review of activities conducted by **Harwood Street Funding I, LLC**, (the "Licensee") and having documented violations of the Residential Mortgage License Act of 1987 (the "Act") [205 ILCS 635] and the rules promulgated under the Act (the "Rules") [38 Ill. Adm. Code 1050], hereby issues this ORDER pursuant to the authority provided under Section 4-5 of the Act. The Department makes the following:

## **FINDINGS**

- 1. That Harwood Street Funding I, LLC is an Illinois residential mortgage licensee holding license number MB.0005731 (the "License"), and located at 2728 N. Harwood, Dallas, Texas 75201;
- 2. That Licensee has failed to perform one or more of the requirements of the Act and Rules described below:
  - a. Failure of Licensee to maintain Surety Bond and Fidelity Bond (205 ILCS 635/3-1 and 38 Ill. Adm. Code 1050.490);
- 3. That the Department made efforts as described below to advise Licensee of these unfulfilled requirements so that Licensee can comply with the Act and Rules:
  - a. That on March 7, 2007, the Department received a Notice of Cancellation letter from Licensee's Insurance Company indicating that coverage shall expire on April 7, 2007;
  - b. That on March 14, 2007, the Department sent to Licensee via U.S. first-class mail service and certified mail, a letter advising Licensee that the surety bond on file with the Department has been cancelled and that such current bond must be submitted to Department within 10 days;

- c. That Licensee's fidelity bond subsequently expired on July 1, 2007;
- d. That a Potential Disciplinary Letter was sent to Licensee on July 31, 2007 via U.S. first-class mail service and certified mail. A signed receipt card evidencing receipt of such delivery was received by the Department on August 10, 2007; and
- e. That Licensee has not submitted to the Department a current surety bond and fidelity bond by the due date.

# **CONCLUSIONS**

BASED UPON THE ABOVE FINDINGS, THE DEPARTMENT IS OF THE OPINION AND CONCLUDES:

- 1. That notwithstanding notices and other efforts by the Department, Licensee failed to respond and submit a current surety and fidelity bond to the Department in a timely manner; and
- 2. That Licensee is not currently complying with the Act and Rules promulgated under the Act.

#### **ORDER**

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. That Harwood Street Funding I, LLC, License No. MB.0005731 shall be and hereby is assessed a fine in the amount of \$5,000;
- 2. The fine in the amount of \$5,000 shall be paid no later than thirty (30) days after service of this Order upon Harwood Street Funding I, LLC; and
- 3. The fine in the amount of \$5,000 shall be paid by means of a certified check or money order made payable to the:
