ORDER REVOKING LICENSE

The DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION, Division of Banking (the "Department"), having conducted a review of activities conducted by **Trump Mortgage, LLC**, (the "Licensee") and having documented violations of the Residential Mortgage License Act of 1987 (the "Act") [205 ILCS 635], hereby issues this ORDER pursuant to the authority provided under Section 4-5(h)(1) of the Act. The Department makes the following:

FINDINGS

1. That Trump Mortgage, LLC is an Illinois residential mortgage licensee holding license number MB.6760247 (the "License"), and located at 40 Wall Street, 25th Floor, Suite 2520, New York, New York 10005;
2. That Licensee has failed to perform one or more of the requirements of the Act and Rules described below:
 - a. Failure of Licensee to maintain Fidelity Bond (205 ILCS 635/3-1); and
 - b. Failure to pay in timely manner any fee, charge or fine, (205 ILCS 635/4-5)(i)(13));
3. That the Department made efforts as described below to advise Licensee of these unfulfilled requirements so that Licensee can comply with the Act and Rules:
 - a. That on June 29, 2007, the Department sent to Licensee via U.S. first-class mail service and certified mail, a letter advising Licensee that the fidelity bond on file with the Department had expired on April 28, 2007 and that a current bond must be submitted to the Department within 10 days;
 - b. That a Potential Disciplinary Letter was sent to Licensee on August 9, 2007 via U.S. first-class mail service and certified mail. A signed receipt card evidencing receipt of such delivery was received by the Department on August 31, 2007;

- c. That on September 28, 2007, the Department issued Orders No. 2007-MBR-130 & 130-b suspending the license and assessing a \$2,500 fine to Licensee; and
- d. That Licensee, has not paid its fine, submitted a fidelity current bond, nor responded to the Department's correspondence.

CONCLUSIONS

BASED UPON THE ABOVE FINDINGS, THE DEPARTMENT IS OF THE OPINION AND CONCLUDES:

1. That notwithstanding notices and other efforts by the Department, Licensee failed to maintain current fidelity bond, and failed to pay its fine in a timely manner; and
2. That Licensee is in violation of Sections 3-1 and 4-5(i)(13) of the Act and Section 1050.490 of the Rules, and is in further violation of Section 4-5(i)(11) and (17) of the Act.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the license of **Trump Mortgage, LLC**, License No. MB.6760247 is revoked by Order of the Department pursuant to Section 4-5(h)(1) of the Act for failure to comply with the provisions cited herein of the Act and rules, effective ten days after receipt of this Order, unless you request a hearing pursuant to the Act and Subpart N of the Rules, including remitting the hearing fee required by Section 1050.210 of the Rules.
