ORDER REVOKING LICENSE

The DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION, Division of Banking (the "Department"), having conducted a review of activities conducted by **Sterling Mortgage Financial Corporation**, (the "Licensee") and having documented violations of the Residential Mortgage License Act of 1987 (the "Act") [205 ILCS 635] and the rules promulgated under the Act (the "Rules") [38 Ill. Adm. Code 1050], hereby issues this ORDER pursuant to the authority provided under Section 4-5 of the Act. The Department makes the following:

FINDINGS

- 1. That Sterling Mortgage Financial Corporation is an Illinois residential mortgage licensee holding license number MB.0004294 (the "License"), and located according to Department records at 4827 W. Irving Park, Chicago, Illinois 60641;
- 2. That Licensee has failed to perform one or more of the requirements of the Act and Rules described below:
 - a. Failure of Licensee to maintain Surety Bond (205 ILCS 635/3-1 and 38 Ill. Adm. Code 1050.490);
 - b. Failure of Licensee to notify the Department of changes to license application information and address change [205 ILCS 635/2-4(s) and 38 Ill. Adm. Code 1050.480];
 - c. Failure of Licensee to properly surrender its license [205 ILCS 635/2-6(e)];

- 3. That the Department made efforts as described below to advise Licensee of these unfulfilled requirements so that Licensee can comply with the Act and Rules:
 - a. That on or around December 2006, the Department notified Licensee of an upcoming exam in January 2007 at which time the Licensee advised the Department that it would be surrendering the License.
 - b. That the Department did not perform the examination and instead mailed the licensee a licensee surrender packet in December 2006;
 - c. That at no time thereafter did Licensee complete and submit its application to surrender the License;
 - d. That on June 27, 2007, the Department sent to Licensee via U.S. first-class mail service and certified mail, a letter advising Licensee that the surety bond on file with the Department had expired on May 22, 2007 and that a current bond must be submitted to the Department within 10 days;
 - e. That a Potential Disciplinary Letter was sent to Licensee on August 9, 2007 via U.S. first-class mail service and certified mail;
 - f. That said letter sent by certified mail was returned to the Department on September 24, 2007 by the U.S. Postal Service as "Return To Sender, Unclaimed, Unable to Forward;" and
 - g. That although Licensee had a telephone conversation with the Department on September 24, 2007 in which Licensee was again advised of outstanding surrender items, Licensee has failed to either maintain or properly surrender its License.

CONCLUSIONS

BASED UPON THE ABOVE FINDINGS, THE DEPARTMENT IS OF THE OPINION AND CONCLUDES:

That notwithstanding notices and other efforts by the Department, Licensee failed to properly surrender its license or provide a current surety bond and changes to license application information and address to the Department in violation of Sections 2-4 (s), 2-6 (e) and 3-1 of the Act and Sections 1050.480 and 1050.490 of the Rules, and in further violation of Section 4-5 (i) (11) and (17) of the Act.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the license of Sterling Mortgage

Financial Corporation, License No. MB.0004294 is revoked by Order of the

Department pursuant to Section 4-5(h) (1) of the Act for failure to comply with the

provisions cited herein of the Act and rules, effective ten days after receipt of this Order,

unless you request a hearing pursuant to the Act and Subpart N of the Rules, including

remitting the hearing fee required by Section 1050.270 of the Rules.
