ORDER ASSESSING FINE

The DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION, Division of Banking (the "Department"), having reviewed and examined the activities of Integrity Mortgage Corporation (the "Licensee") and documented violations of the Residential Mortgage License Act of 1987 (the "Act") [205 ILCS 635] and the rules promulgated under the Act (the "Rules") [38 Ill. Adm. Code 1050], hereby issues this ORDER pursuant to the authority provided under Section 4-5(h)(5) of the Act. The Department makes the following:

FINDINGS

- 1. That Integrity Mortgage Corporation is an Illinois residential mortgage licensee holding license number MB.0005373 (the "License") and located at 1111 Plaza Drive, Suite 300, Schaumburg, IL 60173;
- 2. That on July 21, 2009, the Department examined the licensable activities of Licensee for the period 7/1/2008 to 6/30/2009, and found numerous violations of the Act and Rules as cited in the Report of Examination (the "ROE") and referred the Licensee to Supervision for the ROE to correct and comply with the Act and Rules;
- 3. That on September 10, 2009, the Supervision Section held a supervisory meeting with Licensee to cover items in the ROE. The Department advised Licensee that an enforcement issue was being created for repeat exam violations;
- 4. That on September 11, 2009, the Department's Supervision Section created an enforcement issue for Licensee's repeat exam violations of Rules Sections 1050.1110(d), 1050.1250, and 1050.1350 (citing 24 CFR 3500.7 "Yield Spread Premium" disclosures). These violations were cited in two files for the 2009 exam, and two files for the 2008 exam;
- 5. That on September 14, 2009, the Department's Legal Section mailed to Licensee by U.S. First class and certified postage a Potential Discipline Letter citing the aforementioned violations; and

6. That on November 4, 2009, the Department received a signed receipt of delivery by Licensee from the U.S. Postal Service, with communication from Licensee thereafter; however, violations are repeat and warrant fine herein.

CONCLUSIONS

BASED UPON THE ABOVE FINDINGS, THE DEPARTMENT IS OF THE OPINION AND CONCLUDES:

That notwithstanding notices and other efforts by the Department, Licensee is in violation of Rules Sections 1050.1110(d), 1050.1250, and 1050.1350 (citing violation of 24 CFR 3500.7), and is in further violation of Section 4-5(i) (11) of the Act.

<u>ORDER</u>

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That INTEGRITY MORTGAGE CORPORATION, License No. MB.0005373, shall be and hereby is assessed a fine in the amount of \$500 for the violations cited herein;
- 2. The fine in the amount of \$500 shall be due thirty (30) days after the effective date of this Order upon INTEGRITY MORTGAGE CORPORATION; and
- 3. The fine in the amount of \$500 shall be paid by means of a certified check or money order made payable to the:
