ORDER ASSESSING FINE

The DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION, Division of Banking ("Department"), having conducted an investigation of JUAN C. LOPEZ ("LOPEZ"), 110 Sycamore Ave., Streamwood, Illinois 60107 in connection with his residential mortgage activities with M.S.C. Financial ("Licensee"), and found violations of the Residential Mortgage License Act of 1987 ("Act") hereby issues this ORDER ASSESSING FINE.

STATUTORY PROVISIONS

- 1. Section 1-4(jj) of the Act defines the "mortgage loan originator" ("MLO") as an individual who for compensation or gain or in the expectation of compensation or gain (i) takes a residential mortgage loan application, or (ii) offers or negotiates terms of a residential mortgage loan. Included in the definition are individuals who participate in residential mortgage loan modification activities.
- 2. Section 7-1A of the Act states, in part, it is unlawful for any individual to act or assume to act as a mortgage loan originator, as defined in subsection (jj) of Section 1-4 of the Act, without obtaining a license from the Department.
- 3. Section 7-11 of the Act authorizes the Secretary to issue a cease and desist order to compel the mortgage loan originator to comply with this Act or any other applicable law. A maximum fine is authorized of \$1,000 for each day for each violation of this Act or other applicable law or regulation that is committed, and may be double for repeat violations.
- 4. Section 7-13 of the Act provides a list of prohibited acts and practices for MLOs, including conducting any business covered by this Act without holding a valid license as required under this Act, MLOs are prohibited from violating any rules and regulations and engaging in conduct that constitutes dishonest dealings.

FACTUAL FINDINGS

- 5. LOPEZ holds MLO License No. 031.0030312 issued on May 9, 2011 and expired on December 31, 2011, and LO Registration No. 031.0006518 issued on July 27, 2005 and expired on December 31, 2010.
- 6. On February 7, 2011, the Department opened an investigation of Licensee.
- 7. The Department's investigation found that LOPEZ originated loans for four borrowers (Gomez, Ruiz, Gramarossa, and Gutierrez) under the auspices of M.S.C. Financial prior to his transfer to and sponsorship by M.S.C. Financial being approved by the Department.

LEGAL CONCLUSIONS

BASED UPON THE ABOVE ALLEGATIONS, THE DEPARTMENT FINDS:

8. LOPEZ is in violation of Sections 7-13(6), (8) & (15) of the Act.

NOW IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. JUAN C. LOPEZ shall pay a **FINE** in the amount of \$4,000 as authorized under Section 7-11 of the Act. The fine is payable by certified check or money order within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Order to the:
