AN OVERVIEW OF IDFPF'S NEW ONLINE LICENSING SYSTEM

The Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation launched the Comprehensive Online Regulatory Environment ("CORE") on October 30, 2024. The new licensing solution features a streamlined application process for professionals seeking licensure in Illinois, along with a more efficient review process for all license applications and fees. The Department will be able to notify prospective licensees electronically when applications are received, reviewed, and licenses are issued.



All Departmental licensees will be transitioned to CORE in six phases over the next two years, ensuring it is fully operational for professionals and IDFPF alike.

Professions Available on CORE (as of March 12, 2025)

IDFPF selected three license types to test CORE's functionality. Shortly after the new year, IDFPF added four more license types to CORE and is actively preparing to add all other professions licensed by IDFPF across five additional phases over the next two years:



- Clinical Psychologist
- Music Therapist
- Nail Technician
- Licensed Behavior Analyst
- Licensed Assistant Behavior Analyst
- Behavior Analyst Continuing Education Sponsor
- Licensed Certified Professional Midwife
