LICENSE QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience must comply with the requirements of Section 1370.400 of the Administrative Rules.

REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

You must submit the following:

- 1) A copy of current government issued photo identification (e.g., driver's license, passport).
- 2) Proof of age (e.g., driver's license or copy of birth certificate).
- 3) Social Security Number or tax identification number, as appropriate.
- 4) A passport style photo.
- 5) The required fee set forth in Section 1370.30.
- 6) Proof of a surety bond of no less than \$5,000, to cover financial obligations.
- 7) Proof of a performance bond of no less than \$10,000 guaranteeing payment of all obligations relating to the promotional activities.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ONCE LICENSED

- All Professional Boxing Promoter licenses expire on September 30th of each odd-numbered year, regardless of issuance date.
- It is your responsibility to update your contact information including email address with the Department to ensure that you receive all courtesy renewal email reminders and other notifications.
