LICENSE QUALIFICATIONS

Experience:

- Experience must comply with the requirements of Section 1370.430 of the Administrative Rules.

REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

You must submit the following:

- 1) A copy of current government issued photo identification (e.g., driver's license, passport).
- 2) Proof of age (e.g., driver's license or copy of birth certificate).
- 3) Social Security Number or tax identification number, as appropriate.
- 4) A passport style photo.
- 5) The required fee set forth in Section 1370.30.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ONCE LICENSED

- All Seconds licenses expire on September 30th of each odd-numbered year, regardless of issuance date.
- It is your responsibility to update your contact information including email address with the Department to ensure that you receive all courtesy renewal email reminders and other notifications.
