LICENSE QUALIFICATIONS

Education:

- Baccalaureate Degree

REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

You must submit the following:

- **Official Transcripts-** An official transcript for Baccalaureate Degree, with school seal affixed. If school does not have a seal, transcript must be notarized.
- **CT Official License Certification** — If you have ever been issued a license supporting Document CT must be completed by the U. S. jurisdiction of original licensure (if other than Illinois) and the U. S. jurisdiction where you have most recently been practicing.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ONCE LICENSED

- The certificate of registration for Detection of Deception Trainee shall expire one year from date of issuance and shall only be renewed one time past the initial issuance of the certificate.
