# LICENSE QUALIFICATIONS

#### **Education:**

- EXAMINATION BASED ON EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE-Requires Baccalaureate
  Degree in Law Enforcement, or related field, or business. Requires one (1) year work
  experience out of the five (5) years.
- EXAMINATION BASED ON EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE -Requires Associate Degree in Law Enforcement, or related field, or business. Requires two (2) years work experience out of the five (5) years.
- Supporting Document <u>ED</u> must be completed by a school official and have a school seal affixed. If school has no seal, Supporting Document ED must be notarized.
- If you have completed a non-degree military training program in law enforcement or a
  related fi eld credit shall be given for one of the 3 years of the required experience if it is
  determined that such training is substantially equivalent to that received in an associate
  degree program.

### **Experience:**

If you have ever been licensed as a Private Detective in other states, Supporting Document CT must be completed by the jurisdictions of licensure where you have been practicing. You must direct the licensing agency/board(s) to return completed form CT directly to you.

#### **EXAMINATION - BASED ON EXPERIENCE**

Submit supporting document <u>VE-DET</u> if you are attesting to three (3) years work
experience out of the five (5) years immediately preceding application working
full-time for a licensed private detective agency as a registered private detective
employee; as a full-time investigator for a licensed attorney; for an in-house
investigative unit for a corporation having 100 or more employees or for any of
the armed forces of the United States.

OR

• Submit supporting Document <u>VE-DSC</u> attesting to three (3) years' experience out of the five (5) years immediately preceding application employed as a full-time investigator in a law enforcement agency of the federal government, a state, or a state political subdivision which shall include full-time experience as an investigator with a state's attorney's office or a public defender's office thereof, approved by the Department. (In the case of military police experience, applicant must submit a copy of DD214). In lieu of the experience requirement referenced in item 2 above, alternative experience may be accepted working full-time for a private detective agency licensed in another state or for a private detective agency in a state that does not license such agencies if the experience is substantially equivalent to that gained working for an Illinois licensed private detective agency.

#### OR

For applicants utilizing the experience as referenced in Section 15-10(c) where proof of canine odor detection services for hire since January 1, 2005, is required, the following shall be included: Supporting document <u>VE-CAN</u> to document work experience in canine odor detection services since January 1, 2005; and Certified copies of a minimum of three canine odor detection services contracts prior January 1, 2005.

#### **EXAMINATION BASED ON EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE**

#### **Experience needed with Baccalaureate Degree**

Submit supporting Document <u>VE-DET</u> attesting to one (1) year work
experience out of the five (5) years immediately preceding examination
application working full-time for a licensed private detective agency as a
registered private detective employee or as a full-time investigator for a
licensed attorney; for an in-house investigative unit for a corporation having
100 or more employees or for any of the armed forces of the United States;

#### OR

- Submit supporting Document <u>VE-DSC</u> attesting to one (1) year experience out of the five (5) years immediately preceding examination application employed as a full-time investigator in a law enforcement agency of the federal government, a state, or a state political subdivision, which shall include full-time experience as an investigator with a state's attorney's office or a public defender's office thereof, approved by the Department. (In the case of military police experience, applicant must submit a copy of DD214).
- In lieu of the experience requirement referenced above, alternative experience may be accepted working full-time for a private detective agency licensed in another state or for a private detective agency in a state that does

not license such agencies if the experience is substantially equivalent to that gained working for an Illinois licensed private detective agency.

#### **Experience needed with Associate Degree**

Submit supporting Document <u>VE-DET</u> attesting to one (2) year work
experience out of the five (5) years immediately preceding examination
application working full-time for a licensed private detective agency as a
registered private detective employee or as a full-time investigator for a
licensed attorney; for an in-house investigative unit for a corporation having
100 or more employees or for any of the armed forces of the United States;

#### OR

- Submit supporting Document <u>VE-DSC</u> attesting to one (2) year experience out of the five (5) years immediately preceding examination application employed as a full-time investigator in a law enforcement agency of the federal government, a state, or a state political subdivision, which shall include full-time experience as an investigator with a state's attorney's office or a public defender's office thereof, approved by the Department. (In the case of military police experience, applicant must submit a copy of DD214).
- In lieu of the experience requirement above, alternative experience may be
  accepted working full-time for a private detective agency licensed in another
  state or for a private detective agency in a state that does not license such
  agencies if the experience is substantially equivalent to that gained working
  for an Illinois licensed private detective agency.

# REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

#### You must submit the following:

<u>ED</u>-Certification of Education must be completed by a school official or have school seal affixed. If school has no seal, supporting document ED must be notarized.

**VE-DET**-Supporting Document attesting to type and years of experience.

<u>VE-DSC</u>-Supporting Document attesting to type and years of experience.

<u>VE-CAN</u>-Supporting document attesting to type and years of experience.

**FINGERPRINTS**-Fingerprints must be taken within 60 days from the date that the application is submitted to the Department or the Department's testing vendor. <u>CT</u> - Official License Certification — Persons making application on the basis of experience must provide support document(s). If you have ever been licensed as a private detective in other states, supporting document CT must be completed by the jurisdictions of licensure where you have been practicing. You must direct the licensing agency/board(s) to return completed form CT directly to you.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ONCE LICENSED

- All Private Detective licenses expire on August 31st of each Even-numbered year, regardless of issuance date.
- It is your responsibility to update your contact information including email address with the Department to ensure that you receive all courtesy renewal email reminders and other notifications.
