Important:

- The qualifications for an Illinois naprapath license are provided in 68 Illinois Administrative Code 1295.30 and 1295.40. Part 1295 is referred to as the naprapath rules. Links to the act and rules are available online at <https://idfpr.illinois.gov/profs/napr.html> under Laws and Rules.

LICENSE QUALIFICATIONS

- Completion of a 2-year college level education program or its equivalent at an accredited college or university.
- Graduation from a naprapathic program with a curriculum approved by the American Naprapathic Association, the Illinois Naprapathic Association, or a national or regional accrediting body recognized by the United States Department of Education.
- Successful completion of a written clinical competency examination as provided in Section 1295.10 of the rules. The Division has determined that the approved examination is the Illinois Naprapath Licensure Examination developed by Continental Testing Services, Inc. or a substantially equivalent clinical competency examination for naprapaths.
- Individuals applying for a license by endorsement must be actively licensed as a naprapath in another state or jurisdiction of the United States.
