GENERAL INFORMATION

- A licensed advanced practice registered nurse with full practice authority who prescribes, stores, or dispenses Schedule II, III, IV, or V controlled substances in Illinois must obtain a full practice authority APRN controlled substances registration (prefix 377). A separate registration is required for each practice location where controlled substances are stored or dispensed from. A physical address must be provided for each location. A P.O. Box is not acceptable.
