Final Administrative Decision

On September 3, 2021, the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (“the Department”) announced the following lists of results from the Qualifying Applicant Lottery (conducted on July 29, 2021), the Social Equity Justice Involved Lottery (conducted on August 5, 2021), and the Tied Applicant Lottery (conducted on August 19, 2021) as the Department’s final administrative decision regarding applications for Conditional Adult Use Dispensing Organization Licenses (“Conditional Licenses”) under Sections 15-25 through 15-35.10 of the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act (“Act”). The statutory and administrative abandonment processes for each lottery, as provided by the Act and the Department’s rules, have been completed.

The Conditional Licenses to be awarded by the Department following these lotteries may be subject to change as a result of compliance issues pursuant to section 15-30(g) of the Act, court orders, or administrative review.

Update

September 10, 2021

Pursuant to Section 15-175(a) of the Act, this Final Administrative Decision is subject to judicial review under the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-102. Accordingly, applicants have until October 8, 2021 to file any claims for judicial review, which is 35 days from the Final Administrative Decision of September 3, 2021.
