## IMPORTANT UPDATE ON SURETY BONDS FOR ILLINOIS MONEY TRANSMITTERS

Dear Money Transmitter Licensees:

On August 9, 2024, the Uniform Money Transmission Modernization Act ("MTMA"), 205 ILCS 658/1-1 *et seq.*, became law in Illinois as Public Act 103-0991. Among other changes, the MTMA established new surety bond requirements for licensees. *See* 205 ILCS 658/10-2(b).

For calendar year 2026, all licensees must use an electronic surety bond filed and maintained in NMLS. See 205 ILCS 658/10-2(f). Please convert to an electronic bond as soon as possible. Please also note that the electronic bond must be calculated in accordance with 205 ILCS 658/10-2(b).

ANY LICENSEE THAT HAS NOT OBTAINED AN ELECTRONIC BOND THAT COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF 205 ILCS 658/10-2(b) WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE 2026 RENEWAL OF THEIR ILLINOIS MONEY TRASMISSION LICENSE
