VARIANCE

Pursuant to the authority granted to me by 68 Illinois Administrative Code 1220.441, I hereby grant a Variance to 68 Illinois Administrative Code 1220.415(b)(6), which requires restricted faculty license holders renewing their license to pay a \$150 renewal fee. For renewal year 2024, restricted faculty licensees who paid a renewal fee in the years 2022 or 2023 and whose licenses were terminated and then renewed by the Department of Financial & Professional Regulation (“Department”) shall be waived the renewal fee for the 2024 license renewal cycle.

The purpose of this Variance is to ensure that restricted faculty licensees are not required to double pay for their renewal after the Department changed the renewal schedule for restricted faculty licenses from yearly to every three years in 2021.

This Variance is in no way intended to waive or modify any other statute, rule, or regulation concerning restricted faculty licensees. Licensees shall comply with all additional rules and regulations contained in the Dental Practice Act, et seq., and the rules promulgated thereto.

I have determined that the provision from which this Variance is granted is not statutorily mandated; no party will be injured by the granting of this Variance; and the rules from which this Variance is granted would, in this particular case, be unreasonable.
