### VARIANCE


Pursuant to the authority granted to me by 68 Illinois Administrative Code 1330.70, I hereby grant a Variance to the provisions of 68 Illinois Administrative Code 1330.20(a)(1) and (b)(1), which sets the fee for new applications for a license as a pharmacy technician and pharmacist at \$50 and \$400, respectively. These fees officially went into effect on December 30, 2025.

The purpose of this Variance is to vary 68 Illinois Administrative Code 1330.20(a)(1) and (b)(1) to extend the effective date of these fees for new applications to begin on April 1, 2026. The fees for new applications for a license as a pharmacy technician and pharmacist shall remain \$40 and \$75, respectively, until April 1, 2026. This extension does not apply to new pharmacy applications.

This Variance is in no way intended to waive or modify any statute, rule or regulation concerning the licensure or practice of pharmacy. The Applicant shall comply with all additional rules and regulations contained in the Pharmacy Practice Act, et seq., and the rules promulgated thereto.

I have determined that the provision from which this Variance is granted is not statutorily mandated; no party will be injured by the granting of this Variance; and the rules from which this Variance is granted would, in this particular case, be unreasonable.
