



ILLINOIS ARCHITECT LICENSE RENEWAL

For each renewal cycle, a licensee must obtain 24 total hours of continuing education that meets the requirements listed in Section 1150.105 of the rules for the administration of the architecture practice act. There are sixteen (16) core Health, Safety, Welfare hours and eight (8) elective hours.

The following must be part of the core hours:

- 1) A minimum of one hour of sexual harassment prevention training.
- 2) A minimum of one hour of programs, courses or activities related to design practices that reflect improved understanding of high winds or natural disasters.

All programs or courses shall:

- 1) Contribute to the advancement, extension and enhancement of the professional skills and scientific knowledge of the licensee in practice of architecture;
- 2) Foster the enhancement of general or specialized practice and values of architecture;
- 3) Be developed and presented by persons with education and/or experience in the subject matter of the program; and
- 4) Specify the course objectives, course content and teaching methods to be used.
