PRE-RENEWAL IS OPEN FOR THE ARCHITECT, LAND SURVEYOR AND STRUCTURAL ENGINEER PROFESSIONS

The Architect, Land Surveyor and Structural Engineer professions are currently in pre-renewal and will expire on November 30, 2020. All active licensees were sent a courtesy renewal reminder email in the first week of September. If you did not receive this email, either the email address on record is no longer valid or the email may have been sent to your trash/spam folder.

DID YOU KNOW?

For an online exam/license certification request, if you request a certification for your PE, SE or LS exam/license information to be sent to another jurisdiction or NCEES, all exams passed in Illinois will be sent on the same certification. A separate request is not needed for the FE or FS exam score (assuming it was passed in Illinois).

EMERGENCY RULES NOTIFICATION

As a proactive measure to ensure the health and safety of licensees during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Division submitted an Emergency Rules packet to the Joint Committee on Administrative Review (JCAR) to clarify continuing education/professional development requirements for a number of professions, two of which being the **Professional Land Surveyor** and **Structural Engineer** professions.

In the current Administrative Rules for these two professions, limitations existed that would prohibit licensees from obtaining all required hours online. This Emergency Rules packet amends the current Administrative Rules to allow licensees the ability to complete all hours online, and was published on October 2, 2020 - https://www.cyberdriveillinois.com/departments/index/register/volume44/register_volume44_issue_40.pdf
