Renewal Reminder

The Professional Engineer license is currently in renewal and will expire on February 28, 2022.

A reminder that DPR recently implemented a completely new renewal interface through our Online portal system and all active PE licensees should have received a courtesy email with instructions to renew the license in November of 2021.

At right is a screenshot of the new Online portal you will interface with when you renew your PE license. If you do not currently have an Online account set up with DPR, you will be required to create one prior to completing your renewal.

Architect License Application Change

Candidates applying for an architect license in Illinois who hold an NCARB Record are encouraged to apply using the new Online application. Doing so will reduce your wait time to receive your license, enable you to pay via debit or credit card, and reduce the use of paper consumables.

We recommend that prior to applying, you contact NCARB and request your Record to be sent to the Illinois Jurisdiction as it may take 3-4 weeks to submit the NCARB Record.

You may apply Online for your license here: https://online-dfpr.micropact.com/

Once you create your account and set up your security questions, click on the "Create/Continue Application" link in the middle of the page, select "Architecture Board" and then "Licensed Architect" to begin your application.

As you are submitting an NCARB Record, when prompted to upload documents during the application process, simply upload a document stating "See NCARB Record" and DPR staff will know to know to look for it.
