ILLINOIS PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR LICENSE RENEWAL

For each renewal cycle, a licensee must obtain 20 total hours of professional development that meets the requirements listed in Section 1270.65 of the rules for the administration of the professional land surveyor practice act. There are seven (7) core hours and thirteen (13) elective hours.

Applicable Sections of the Rules:

- Section 1270.50 Renewals
- <u>Section 1270.65 Professional Development</u>

Core hours include:

- 1) A minimum of one hour of sexual harassment prevention training.
- 2) A minimum of four hours of programs, courses or activities in the area of Illinois statutes and rules that regulate professional land surveyors and surveys.
- A minimum of two hours of programs, courses, or activities in the area of professional conduct.

All programs or courses shall:

- Contribute to the advancement, extension and enhancement of the professional skills and scientific knowledge of the licensee in practice of professional land surveying;
- Foster the enhancement of general or specialized practice and values of professional land surveying;
- Be developed and presented by persons with education and/or experience in the subject matter of the program; and
- 4) Specify the course objectives, course content and teaching methods to be used.
