YOU'VE TAKEN AN NCEES EXAM... GREAT! NOW WHAT?

- 1. A grade notice will be posted to your NCEES account once NCEES scores the examination.
- 2. If you **FAILED** the examination, you must re-register with NCEES to sit for the next available exam.
- 3. If you **PASSED** the examination, please refer to the appropriate section below.

- 5. Pursuant to recent changes in the Rules for the administration of the Illinois SE Act, all applicants are authorized to register and sit for the FE and/or SE exam without pre-approval by the Board; however, you must meet the requirements in effect at the time when you apply for enrollment or licensure.

ENROLLMENT AS A STRUCTURAL ENGINEER INTERN (SEI)

Important information once licensed.

- All Structural Engineer licenses expire on November 30th of even-numbered years, regardless of issuance date.
- You are exempt of the CE requirement for your initial renewal.
- It is your responsibility to update your contact information including email address with the Department to ensure that you receive all courtesy renewal email reminders and other notifications.
- We highly recommend that you review the Code Enforcement Manual as it will provide a sample of what your Illinois license seal/stamp should look like and other useful information regarding your profession.
