CONTINUING EDUCATION (CE):

- Licensees are required to complete 28 hours of CE that includes a 7-hour USPAP course in addition to a 1-hour Sexual Harassment Prevention Training ("SHPT"), for a total of 29 hours. **If your initial license was issued on or after April 1, 2025, you do not have to complete CE for this renewal.**
- CE for this renewal must have been completed between October 1, 2023, and September 30, 2025.
- **Courses taken outside of Illinois through education providers not approved by the Department must be submitted on the EDU-8000 Out-of-State CE Request form prior to September 30, 2025.** Not every course taken in another jurisdiction is or will be approved for CE in Illinois. Submission of the form does not guarantee acceptance by the Department for CE approval.
- **The 15-Hour National USPAP Course or its equivalent is not accepted as a substitute for the 7-Hour National USPAP Update or its equivalent.**
