CONTINUING EDUCATION FACT SHEET 2026 AUCTIONEER RENEWAL

- The 2026 Auctioneer Renewal deadline is December 31, 2026.
- Prior to renewing a license, the licensee shall complete the required courses as described below.

Continuing Education (CE) Hour Requirements

If the auctioneer was first issued a license on or before December 31, 2024:

- 12 hours of CE is required, of which a minimum of 6 hours must be approved as mandatory hours, and a <u>Sexual Harassment</u> Prevention Training.
- Note: The Sexual Harassment Prevention Training may be counted towards elective hours if completed through an approved education provider.

If the auctioneer was first issued a license between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2026:

• No CE is required for this renewal.

Certification of Compliance with Continuing Education Requirements

- Each renewal applicant shall certify on the renewal application that they have fully complied with the CE and Sexual Harassment Prevention Training course requirements.
 - Licensees that are exempt from the CE requirements for this renewal should certify on the renewal application that they have complied with the CE requirements.
- 2) The Department may require additional evidence demonstrating compliance with the CE requirements. It is the responsibility of each renewal applicant to retain or otherwise produce evidence of such compliance upon request.
