HOW APPLICATION BY ENDORSEMENT WORKS

If you are a *Certified Residential* or a *Certified General* real estate appraiser from another jurisdiction, you *may* be eligible to apply for the *same* credential in Illinois.

- 1) Complete the standard application that can be found at:
<https://idfpr.illinois.gov/content/dam/soi/en/web/idfpr/forms/dre/rea1001.pdf>
 - a) **You do NOT have to complete the attached experience LOG.**
- 2) Remit the application and fee payment to the address on the application.
 - a) **You do NOT have to obtain or submit a Letter of Good Standing from your current juris-diction.**
- 3) Once we receive your completed application, **Licensing & Testing** will attach your **ASC Na-tional Registry** information to your application.
 - a) **You do NOT have to take or pass an Illinois real estate appraisal exam**
- 4) If everything is in order, your application will be reviewed and approved.
 - a) **Note:** Criminal convictions (*other than minor traffic violations*), professional license disciplines, delinquent student loans, delinquent tax liabilities, and delinquent child support payments may delay the review of your application for licensure.
