Reports

Mr. Marion reported for December 1, 2024 through December 12, 2024: 54 complaints were received; 8 complaints were referred to Medical Prosecutions for review; 60 complaints were closed; there were 571 open investigations; and the average caseload for an investigator was 82 cases.

Dr. Goyal reported that as of December 16, 2024, there were 106 cases assigned to the medical coordinators with 24 agreements of care, counseling, or treatment (CCT), and 326 cases monitored by the Probation unit.

Mr. Thom reported that as of December 16, 2024, there were 933 open cases assigned to the Medical Prosecutions unit.
