A Motion was made by Flores and Acosta to allow Alonzo-Deubel to attend the meeting by other means pursuant to Section 7(a) of the Open Meetings Act (5 ILSA 120/7). The motion was passed unanimously.

Approval of Minutes:

Anyone who has taken a reciprocity exam and submits their application for licensure before January 1, 2026, will still be eligible to become licensed by reciprocity.




### 2025 Managing Broker Initial Licenses Issued




2025 Initial Broker Licenses Issued by Month




2025 Broker Renewals by Month

### 2025 Residential Leasing Agent Initial Licenses Issued by Month




### 2025 Residential Leasing Agent Renewals by Month

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

Licensees that have not yet had an examination in the Chicago Area region are continuing to be assigned to the non-Chicago area region examiners. In the effort to accelerate the number of examinations to be conducted, *Brokerage Verification Reports* are being emailed to these licensees. The *BVR* report allows the examiner to assess the level of activity of the licensee then complete the examination process by email or schedule an on-site examination. Examiners are also completing onsite examinations in their region as well as working off-site examinations in the Chicago Region.

The total number of initial examinations closed in **NOVEMBER** was: **24 files**.
