Reports

Mr. Marion reported for the month of April 1, 2026 through April 29, 2026:

180 complaints were received; 33 complaints were referred to Medical Prosecutions for review; 97 complaints were closed; there were 680 open investigations; and the average caseload for an investigator was 97 cases.

Dr. Goyal reported that as of May 6, 2026, there were 132 cases assigned to the medical coordinators with 25 agreements of care, counseling, or treatment (CCT), and 227 cases monitored by the Probation unit.

Ms. Pipolo reported that as of May 6, 2026, there were 965 open cases assigned to the Medical Prosecutions unit.

Public Comment

Ana Chaves from the Chiropractic Freedom Coalition and had no comment.

Michael Guinasso from the Chiropractic Freedom Coalition shared information about the April 30, 2026 FCLB annual meeting in Atlanta. He raised concerns about the FCLB budget, and the voting methods used for the proposed merger with NBCE.
