## **Reports**

Mr. Marion reported for the month of June 1, 2026 through June 24, 2026:

163 complaints were received; 23 complaints were referred to Medical Prosecutions for review; 291 complaints were closed; there were 649 open investigations; and the average caseload for an investigator was 93 cases.

Dr. Goyal reported that as of July 1, 2026, there were 119 cases assigned to the medical coordinators with 25 agreements of care, counseling, or treatment (CCT), and 207 cases monitored by the Probation unit.

Ms. Pipolo reported that as of July 1, 2026, there were 950 open cases assigned to the Medical Prosecutions unit.

### **Public Comment**

Ana Chaves from the Chiropractic Freedom Coalition addressed his concerns with the merger of FCLB and NBCE, the FCLB budget, and voting methods from the FCLB annual meeting held on April 30, 2026 in Atlanta Georgia.
