Announcements/Introductions	Board members and Division staff introduced themselves.
Board Minutes	Board reviewed open minutes for September 9, 2016 business meeting. Motion made (Amarantos) and seconded (Brezinski) to approve the minutes. Motion passed by majority vote. Yes- Borreggine, Amarantos, Brezinski, Wray; No- None; Abstain- Ward.
Mandatory Report Process - Jeff Atterberry	Mr. Atterberry described the mandatory report process concerning malpractice settlements. When a malpractice settlement is paid on behalf of a licensee, the Division is notified by the insurance company. The Enforcement Unit sends notice to the licensee advising of the right to respond to the mandatory report. The Enforcement Unit also requests consent from the patient to obtain medical records related to the mandatory report. If the patient does not provide consent, the Division cannot compel patient records be provided to the Division.
Rules Update	The Board discussed recent changes to the Administrative Rules including removal of the work history requirement and the revisions to the temporary license language based on changes in the Podiatric Medical Practice Act.
Board Concerns	Dr. Borreggine expressed his concern that the Board only meets twice per year. He questioned how involved the Board was in licensing and enforcement matters. It was discussed that the Board serves an advisory role to the Director of Professional Regulation on matters governing the administration and enforcement of the act. The Director relies on the Board's expertise and its recommendations when making a final decision on licensing and disciplinary matters.
