NEW BUSINESS Announcement and Introductions	The Board members and DPR staff introduced themselves. Chairperson Williams-Schafer introduced Ms. Donya Adkerson.	
FY2015 Board Meeting Schedule	The next meeting is scheduled for March 26, 2015 in Springfield.	The Board schedule for the next fiscal year (FY2016) will include meetings in March and September.
Associate Sex Offender Provider education and licensure requirements	The Board members discussed the issue of applicants not meeting the education requirements of the associate level license. Most of the deficient education programs are psychology or counseling programs.	The Board members would like to establish minimum criteria for education programs in the Rules and are interested in changing the current accreditation language in Rules Section 1280.50 c) 1).

Associate Sex Offender Provider education and licensure requirements (con't.)	The Board noted that there is a large discrepancy in education credentials, particularly in counselor programs. The Act requires a master's degree in a mental health or closely related field; the Rules further define the requirement and include accreditation requirements. Ms. Adkerson expressed concern that the requirement is creating a shortage of providers in the East St. Louis and Madison County areas.	Further discussion on this subject will be held at the next Board meeting on March 26. The members will review the education language in the Psychology and Counselor rules.
Change in licensure requirements effective January 1, 2015	It was noted that the grandfather period ended on January 1, 2015.	Applicants must now submit proof of meeting the training, supervised experience and evaluation requirements for licensure. Applications are updated to reflect the requirements.
Investigations and Enforcement Procedures	Attorney Akram told the Board that the DPR Investigations Unit is receiving complaints against licensees from detainees who have completed jail sentences but are not yet released from prison. The Investigations Unit is asking for guidance on these types of complaints and requesting information on standards of practice.	Several of the members work in this area and are available to meet with DPR staff to provide guidance. Ms. Akram will forward the information to the appropriate DPR staff.
